

DECEMBER 2023

December is right in the midst of Advent, a season of waiting and remembering Christ, our Savior, coming to earth in the form of a human child. He “who in the very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, but instead humbled himself, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness” (Philippians 2:6-7). We are reminded in the previous verse that our attitudes should be the same as that of Christ Jesus. Many of us are living incarnationally in our host countries. We are obeying Christ by being the light of the world (Matt 5:14), shining His light and life to those around us. In places

May he whose second Coming in power and great glory we await, make us steadfast in faith, joyful in hope, and constant in love.

May we, who rejoice in the first Advent of our Redeemer, at his second Advent be rewarded with unending life.

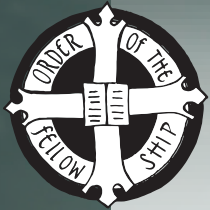
And the blessing of God Almighty, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, be upon us and remain with us forever. Amen.”

PRAYER PRACTICE:

As you observe the lights of Christmas around you or as you light your own Advent candles, pray this month for Christ’s light to penetrate the dark places in the areas where you serve. Pray specifically for “lights” in the souls of fellow believers to shine brighter this season as more people seek hope. Pray for Christ to ignite His light into the souls of those seeking Truth. If you don’t already have 3 people you are intentionally praying to come to Christ, then choose 3 people in your everyday comings and goings for Christ to specially shine His light into this month. Pray for the veil to be removed from their hearts and minds. (1 Cor 3:16)

FASTING PRACTICE:

This month, if you haven’t already bought all your Christmas presents, pray and think about how you can intentionally create a gift for someone instead of purchasing a gift. Ask God to help you use your God-given ability to create and bring joy and beauty to someone else in the form of something you’ve made especially for them. If you feel led, make multiple gifts instead of purchasing them! Use this as a way to fast from the pull of materialism and consumerism this holiday season while connecting to God’s nature of creativity within you.
