In Ethiopia, this is a season of change. The rains are starting. Sandals get put away and boots come out, hot and sunny days become cold and cloudy, and instead of carrying sunblock with us all the time, now it's our raincoats.

Many Christians in Ethiopia use the rainy season to reflect on their faith. Sometimes the rains are so hard they cause floods and destruction. Farmers say this is a season of hard work and suffering - cold weather, plowing, mud, and long hours of toil. It's the necessary struggle that precedes the harvest. It reminds us that forces of destruction can also clear space for new life and growth. And this season helps us recognize that the yield comes through our partnership with God - we do what is ours to do and have faith that God is doing His part too.

If this is a season of struggle for you, may you be strengthened by the words of Psalm 126, "Those who sow with tears will reap with songs of joy. Those who go out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with them."

but so will I.

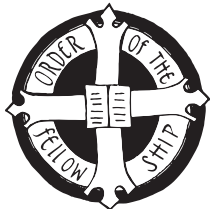
