This was traumatic for my daughter and I was unsure of what to do. I spoke with our cook and found that this behavior is in no way acceptable. He was downright appalled. He also knew the man selling vegetables that witnessed the whole thing. I have not seen the boys since. We live in places where life is different. Expectations are different. Behavior is different. Sometimes we think there are enemies where there are none. Sometimes we can be perceived as enemies to others. Sometimes we don't understand when a transgression has happened. But in all things, it is Christ who judges. We must walk before him blamelessly. We must allow Him to judge, as we go to him in prayer, sometimes not knowing what we are praying for. He is the Creator God, and we are but his creation.

PRAYER FOR OCTOBER:

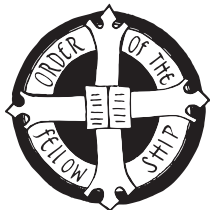
